IMPORTANT TIPS

- Use the correct application. Do not use an application from a previous year.
- This application has two required parts: **Student Application** and **Academic Transcripts**.
- Print neatly or type your application.
- Make sure to include city, state and zip code. Do not use abbreviations for your city.
- Provide an active email address that you check frequently and a phone number, including the area code, where you can be reached in case of questions.
- Fill in all sections of the application. If a section does not apply to you, use "Not Applicable" (N/A). Double-check for completeness and accuracy to avoid delays or disqualification.
- Make sure all required items are included. If any part is missing, you will be disqualified.
- Submitted photo should be a head-and-shoulders shot with dimensions of at least 800 x 1000 pixels, a file size between 500 KB and 5 MB, and a minimum resolution of 300 DPI. Please ensure the image is in portrait orientation, ideally with a plain background.
- Acceptable file formats for photos are JPEG or PNG. Application and transcripts must be PDF.
- We only accept completed **Student Applications** and **Academic Transcripts** via email.
